

**Advertisement for Bids
Pine River Recreation Trail Resurfacing Project
Richland County, WI**

The Richland County Parks Commission will receive sealed bids Pine River Recreation Trail Resurfacing Project at the Land Conservation Department at 26136 Executive Lane Suite C, Richland Center WI 53581 until 5:30 p.m., April 4, 2022. All bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at that time.

The work for which the bids are asked includes the following: Grading sections of the trail, resurfacing sections of the trail with screenings and installing a rock crossing. The work must be completed by November 15, 2022.

Bidding documents may be examined at the Richland County Land Conservation Department located at 26136 Executive Lane, Room 102, Richland Center WI 53581 from the Richland County Parks Commission.

Any proposals shall be submitted shall be submitted in an opaque envelope, on the form provided, and marked with the name and address of the bidder and accompanied by the bid security. If the proposal is sent through the mail, or other delivery system, the sealed envelope shall be enclosed in a separate envelope marked with the notation "BID ENCLOSED" and address to the Richland County Parks Commission, 26136 Executive Lane Suite C, Richland Center WI 53581.

No proposal shall be accepted unless accompanied by a certified check or bid bond equal to at least 5% of the amount bid, payable to Richland County Parks Commission as a guarantee that, if the bid is accepted, the bidder will execute and file the proper contract and bond within 15 days after the award of the contract. The certified check or bid bond will be returned to the bidder as soon as the contract is signed, and if after 15 days the bidder fails to do so, the certified check or bid bond shall be forfeited to the Owner as liquidated damages. Proof of insurance for \$2,000,000.00 is also required with the bid.

Minimum salaries and fringes to be paid on the project shall be in accordance with the prevailing wage rate scale established by the Federal Department of Labor (DOL). Attention is called to the fact that not less than the minimum salaries and fringes set forth in the Contract Documents must be paid on this project, and that the contractor must ensure that employees and applications for employment are not discriminated against because of their race, color, religion, sex, national origin, or other protected class. Federal Labor standards program laws, including, but not limited to the Davis Bacon Act, the Copeland Anti-Kickback Act, and the Contract Work Hours and Safety Standards Act will apply to all projects.

No bidder may withdraw his/her bid within 30 days after the actual day of the opening thereof.

Richland County reserves the right to waive any informality or to reject all bids.
